Organises on a regional basis, a bonsai amateur new talent competition each year, which aims to encourage those participating to do talks/ demonstrations.

Supports financially and/or materially those societies wishing to put on a national or regional bonsai event.

Promotes bonsai in the U.K. by exhibiting trees at Royal Horticultural Shows

e.g. Chelsea and Gardeners World Live. (Members of FoBBS societies have an opportunity to have trees selected for these events).

Provides £5 million comprehensive/3rd party insurance to member societies at a very competitive rate. Maintains the National Bonsai Collection at the Birmingham Botanical Gardens.

Maintains an up-to-date and comprehensive website.

Is in the process of developing a speakers training programme for those wishing to develop presentation skills in giving bonsai talks and demonstrations.

Developing a series of Bonsai Educational Powerpoint presentations to be available for hire by societies for use when short of a speaker.

#### **Work in Progress at The National Bonsai Collection**

Earlier this year the team of volunteers from the Midland region who work regularly to keep the National Bonsai Collection in pristine condition decided that the Juniper group, donated many, many years ago to the collection by the late Bill Horan, first secretary to the Federation, had grown too large to be vulnerable to theft – it is now in a tray of over 5 feet in length, so it was time to make it a feature in the outside space.

However it was still unfortunately vulnerable to the fingers of the thousands of schoolchildren in the groups that regularly visit the Collection in the course of the year. Thus The Botanical Gardens requested a protective fence – the volunteers got together, plans were made and a fence built off site. This last week at the end of June the fence was erected.

## European Bonsai Association

# **EBA**



Since the first informal contacts between European Bonsai enthusiast in Heidelberg (1980), the European Bonsai Association (EBA) has acted as a coordinating body for bonsai organisations within its member countries. The primary aim of the association acting as a non-profit making organisation, has been to promote bonsai art and culture, stimulating its members and teaching them all aspects of the art and science of bonsai.

Much of this has been and continues to be achieved through the bonsai associations and federations within the nineteen member countries

It is by virtue of the efforts of these member countries that bonsai in Europe today is enjoying such a high degree of popularity. Within each of these countries, Bonsai groups and societies meet on regular basis, holding exhibitions and small conventions. In most instances, the societies join together under the auspices of their national association to put on a major event, often in the form of a national convention, which includes an exhibition bringing together a wide range of quality bonsai specimen from that country.

Ever since its establishment, EBA has held annual conventions by a different member country and has equally ensured that the 4th World Bonsai Convention was held in München in 2001.

### World Bonsai Friendship Federation

# WBFF



To promote and diffuse throughout the world, bonsai a living art that can be appreciated by all peoples.

To exchange knowledge, technology, information, and related matters to the art of bonsai among countries of the world, thus advancing international friendship and goodwill.

To sponsor and promote World Bonsai Convention (WBC) once every four years.

Since the late 1970's Saburo Kato, Haruo Kaneshiro, John Naka, and Ted Tsukiyama worked tirelessly to create the World Bonsai Friendship for the pure love of bonsai. The catalyst for the creation of WBFF was "Expo '70" held in 1970 in Osaka, Japan. During this World's Fair, the efforts and unity of the Japanese bonsai community, including Saburo Kato's noble precept of "World Peace through Bonsai," was formulated.

Once established, WBFF's Bylaws divided the world into 9 regions, and required that each region would have a regional organization represented on the WBFF Board of Directors. The regions comprised:

Africa
Australia/New Zealand
China (including Taiwan)
Europe
India
Japan
Asia-Pacific (excluding China, India and Japan)
Latin America (including Mexico and the Caribbean)
North America (Canada/U.S.A)

WBFF's North American Region originally included Canada, the United States, Mexico and the Caribbean. However, with deference to their languages differences, the WBFF Bylaws were later amended to place Mexico and the Caribbean in the Latin American Region. Hence, since 2007 the North American Region has included only Canada and the United States.


This year a long standing member Wendy Curtis was rewarded for her patience and skills. Wendy was awarded first prize in this year's show.

#### Chichester & District Bonsai Society Annual Show. 8th & 9th July 2017.

One of the hottest weekends this year saw members of seven bonsai societies meeting up at Manor Nursery Garden Centre in Chichester for the seventh annual show of the Chichester & District Bonsai Society.

The Societies represented were, in no particular order, Solent, Eastleigh, Surrey Heath, Crawley, Sutton, Eastbourne and Chichester. Making this show probably the largest of its kind on the south coast this year.

Manor Nursery give the use of half their covered display area over to the show and where, the previous week, there had been flowers and bedding plants for this weekend there is a glorious display of bonsai for the public to come and see, marvel over and ask questions, which the attending society members were more than pleased to answer. As there is no entry charge exact figures are unknown but this year at least a couple of hundred people came to see the displays on both days.

Trade stands were supplied by Collette Harrison of Bonsai Trees Southampton and Paul and Gill Canham of Pinecone Ceramics.

Rob Stewart from Eastleigh Bonsai carried out four demonstrations over the two days and freely gave advice to all and everyone that asked.

Trees and displays were judged by Collette Harrison and Paul Eslinger and awards were made as follows.

Dear Editor.

Bonsai trading seems to be going through quite a rough patch at the moment. The first Birmingham sale is usurped by the dinotronic lobby and then the second one is also ousted by presumably another more heavy-weight, read 'moneyed' set-up. The BTA Capel Manor show is squeezed into a fraction of the space we usually use and customers are upset by being made to pay an increased entrance for a 'garden show' which should be reported to the trade description people. The October Elsecar show is cancelled because another organisation wants to book all the space. The same kind of influence is in the ascendancy in all these affairs; that of "money talks" and trust and loyalty are old fashioned values to be cast aside when it suits. People will say that we live in harsh economic times but we always do to some extent and we've never been treated as disposably until this year.

On another subject, the Fenland Club was recently sent details of an auction in which bonsai trees and accessories were offered and I wondered if it would be a positive step for FoBBs (actually mandkhughes) to semi-officially approach more national auction houses to establish their views on selling trees etc. We all know that the standard of trees is slowly rising and the average age of the bonsai aficionado is hardly falling, so there will be some good quality trees increasingly available and need to be more widely known to the bonsai-buying public. I already know of good quality and originally very expensive trees which have expired due to lack of care or interest by the people left behind who neither knew how to keep them alive nor sell them and it is such a shame that others cannot access these to take these trees further into loveliness. Yes, trees are advertised on Ebay and the like but so are 'bonsai seed kits', the offering of which should be outlawed. Bonsai shows, whilst attracting people from far and wide, have a limited customer base. Auction houses are often online so trees can be exposed to a larger audience and this will enable the second or third hand tree market to establish appropriate value in the true sense of the word. When I die I don't want my trees to be left to die. I want someone to continue to develop my trees with skill and enthusiasm and I really don't care how much or even if they pay my heirs as long as the trees are cared for. Just thinking really ...

#### **Wessex Bonsai Show 2017**

The individual competition, now in its 27th year, reduced the number of entries to provide increased space for each tree, allowing for a total of 46 entries in five classes: broadleaf, conifer, fruiting and flowering, self-styled and small trees (combining shohin and mame). Due to their popularity in 2016, judging was again undertaken by a trio of Geoff Crowe, John Lee and Allan Tolley from Phoenix Bonsai Group. The winning entries were Mike Fieldhouse (broadleaf), Bob Savage (conifer), Tony Oswin (flowering), Tony Oswin (self-styled) and Anthony Stribling (small tree). Tony Oswin won the prize for the most points across categories and the award for best tree in the competition was won by Mike Fieldhouse. Malcolm Driffield won the Anderson Trophy for best Wessex club member's tree.

In addition to the Wessex Bonsai club display, this year's show attracted impressive displays of members' trees from ten clubs in the south of England and south Wales (Celtic Knot, Dragon, Eastleigh, Newbury, Phoenix, Solent, Staverton, Swindon, Surrey Heath and Warminster). Celtic Knot won the prize for best club display with a rather unusual presentation. The annual Jack Bellinger trophy, awarded to the best display of three trees in an annual competition between Eastleigh, Solent and Wessex bonsai clubs, was this year won by Solent Bonsai. Jack, who originated this competition, was a member of Eastleigh Bonsai and was passionate about the creation of bonsai, as opposed to what he regarded as 'cheque book' bonsai. Demonstrations by John Lee, Malcolm Driffield and Tony Oswin took place during the day and no bonsai show is complete without a good selection of trade stands, which this year included sales of 'Mopots' and trees from the estate of the late Maureen and Dave Turner.

At a time when many smaller clubs find it hard to put on shows of their own, we are pleased that Wessex has been able to continue to host this event and attract an impressive array of bonsai talent from such a wide area. #### Eastbourne and Wealden Bonsai Club

Held their annual show on Sunday 11th June at Herstmonceux Village Hall, East Sussex, it was a great success again this year. We invited four other clubs to display trees; Solent Bonsai Society, Surrey Heath Bonsai Society, Chichester Bonsai Society and Eastleigh Bonsai Group. All four clubs brought some excellent trees for their displays. Solent Bonsai Society was voted the best display by Eastbourne and Wealden Club members. We invite the public to vote on the best entry. This was won by Kevin Fletcher for a larch group. We were pleased to welcome Reg Bolton, Swindon Bonsai Society to judge member's entries. Reg is of course well known nationally through FoBBS and achieving eight gold medals at Chelsea for the society but also throughout Europe as President of the European Bonsai Association for many years. Reg judged a large broom style lime, shown by Colin George, as the best deciduous tree and the best in show. There were five other winners for various classification as well as six entries highly commended.

Reg also spoke in the afternoon, commenting on some of the entries pointing out both the best aspects of trees and where they might be improved.

We had Paul Eslinger from Eastleigh Bonsai Group, known for his expertise with Satsuki Azaleas. Paul gave a talk and demonstration on care of azaleas. We a further had a talk and demonstration by Dave Penny known for his demonstrations with conifers and saikei. Dave gave a demonstration of styling and wiring a newly acquire conifer.

Club member Derek Brooks had a display of Chinese Brush painting and demonstrated this art form. Our club has the benefit of having members from two local businesses, Peter Ling from Downsview Bonsai and Paul and Gillian Canham from Pinecone Ceramics. They are a huge asset to the club sharing their knowledge with members and they provided the sales tables at the show. Peter brought starter material, established trees and tools and Paul and Gillian a large variety of handmade pots.

An enjoyable day was had by visitors and members alike, enjoying light refreshments and a chance to win a raffle prize as well as so much to appreciate in the world of bonsai.

Thanks must be given to all club members for all their hard work, also to the other clubs for taking part, to our excellent demonstrators and to everybody that came to support our show.




