It also reminds me of the changes that appear to have taken place over the years with society members. As someone who has been on the speakers/demonstrators circuit for many years, the decline in numbers is obvious. Not only that, but recruiting new members, particularly those of the "younger" age group appears to be more and more difficult. You have to ask the question – to what extent have computers and social media eclipsed youngsters going out for an evening to a society?..... we are not only talking of bonsai societies here. It is less than ten years ago that I did a talk to my local horticultural society with an audience of nearly eighty. Within five years, due to decline in membership, and a largely elderly membership at that, the society in question ceased to exist.

At this time, we have not even got onto the topic of "costs" relating to the hobby! Enough said already.

What does however prove to be an area where numbers remain steady, if not actually showing an increase, is attendance at bonsai events. This last month, the 'Noelanders Trophy' once again proved to be a popular draw. Over the years that I have attended this event, numbers attending have always been high, but what has become more noticeable is the increased numbers of Brits turning up for the occasion. This event now attracts in excess of 100 Brits to cross the channel in what can often prove very bad weather in the middle of winter. Something of a paradox one might say when viewed against the decline in society membership numbers together, in recent times, with a slight decline in actual bonsai societies here in the UK. This event attracts up to 75 traders from around Europe and the organiser Marc Noelanders talks of that increasing still further.

It will be interesting to see what happens next year, 2017, when the 'Noelanders Trophy' will be host to the annual European Bonsai Association Congress. Shortly after, at the end of April, the 8th World Bonsai Friendship Federation Convention will be held in Saitama, Japan – a number of Brits I have spoken to see this as a 'once-in-a-lifetime' opportunity, so I suspect quite a few people will have now established for themselves a 'Japan 2017 Fund'!!

By the time this edition goes to print, the 2017 'Winter Image Show' hosted by the Swindon Bonsai Society will have taken place – reports on this event in the April issue.

In conclusion, a number of member societies are now sending their programmes for the year; this is great, but could I please ask that these are kept concise – we have introduced a new page for them but there is only space for bare details.

**Comments From Sandy Reid, Wisbech**

Malcolm, your comment that exhibitions of bonsai ignite enthusiasm, and are a window for all society members and the general public alike, is so true. Peter Warren's provocative article on where the craft moves from here is similarly stimulating.

Peter's first thoughts on individuals being willing to pay to exhibit struck a chord. The majority of bonsai enthusiasts who I meet professionally consider bonsai to be a cheap hobby. Trees which are considered for purchase are looked for as bargains with a 'deal' being seen as part of the purchase. Club members are very willing to give their time, construction skills and effort to produce and staff club exhibition stands and these are often of a high standard to show the trees exhibited in a good light. But individuals personally paying to exhibit? I don't know?

My club has eleven members, all of whom are now over 60, and most of whom attend every meeting. We are very aware that the club will decline as we all age and if no new blood comes in. Our personal enthusiasms are as high and our bonsai-learning rates are probably higher than ever due to professional instruction within the group. Our meetings are dynamic, active and invigorating and certainly a highlight of my life. We have put on exhibitions to attract new members and several existing members have come through these. Showing trees does work in getting the word out there.

I know that there are many bonsai growers who beaver away by themselves and either do not know of their local club or consider it irrelevant. More than once we know of their interest only after their demise when their partner approaches us to dispose of the collection. Yes, some collections are composed of 'sticks in pots' but others are large and well-cared for. Clubs should support the individual member to progress their trees. A disappointing lack of positive tree development must be the major factor in so many giving up bonsai. Many clubs, I would suggest, are not doing this and will in time collapse. It was so good to hear of the North Stoke and Staffs group initiative.


