IN THIS ISSUE

Although too late for the March edition of 'Bonsai News UK', we now have a report and images of the first major UK bonsai even of the year, the 'Winter Image Show' hosted by the Swindon Bonsai Society. Once again, this proved a highly successful enterprise on the part of the Society and congratulations to all those who assisted in putting on the event.

Apart from an impressive exhibition and trade fair, one interesting aspect was the introduction of a different approach to judging the trees and displays for the various awards presented. The issue of judging bonsai has always resulted in interesting and sometimes animated discussions, including such issues as to who are best suited to judging through to whether one has a 'scoring system'; how one overcomes subjectivity and guarantees objectivity? Opinions vary considerably and there come times when, at a personal level, I wonder if there will ever be a definitive system of judging that all bonsai enthusiast will embrace?

The Birmingham Botanical Gardens hosted a double event on Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> March. The first was the now,the well established, 'Bonsai Boot Sale' an annual fund-raising exercise for the National Bonsai Collection, established at the Gardens back in the early 1990's. Again this proved a successful event, with 27 "boots" in attendance and raising the sum of £405.00 towards the running of the Collection. Our thanks to all who attended and making it a successful morning.

This was followed by the FoBBS and National Bonsai Collection AGM with representation from 24 member societies. Minutes of these meetings will appear on the FoBBS website in the next few weeks (www.fobbsbonsai.co.uk).

The meeting highlighted FoBBS continued assistance to societies, particularly those requiring support for events, as well as providing regular updated information. There still, however, remains one weak link – the failure on the part of some societies to provide all the necessary contact details, or more often than not, failing to update society contact details when there are committee changes or changes of e-mail addresses. The FoBBS administration would appeal to all societies to ensure that upto-date contact details are made available at all times, it is the societies to lose out.

Lastly, April through to the end of May sees a number of bonsai events taking place throughout the UK. If your society is one of those putting on an event, then please let us have a report and images following the event. Details and dates appear on this months' World Bonsai Friendship Federation' Calendar of Events.

#### Swindon & District Annual Winter Image Show Feb. 2016

Another grand bonsai event to start the 2016 season, the first large UK show of the season hosted by Swindon and District Bonsai Society. This year's show was a resounding success with over 500 attendees; visitors, traders, clubs and societies, judges, and invited guests as well as club members. The show greeted with great enthusiasm and was in full swing by midday with the main hall and the smaller hall full to capacity, with a full and overflowing car park. The traders did a roaring trade. With a lot of enthusiastic contemplation of the stunning bonsai displays and active discussion on style, form, shape and overall artistic impression. This year the bonsai displays were of a high standard with stunning tokonoma displays, shohin and mame displays as well as club displays.

This was the year chosen to test a new approach to judging on a large scale, similar to a system used at large shows around the world.

There was a public vote for their best tree, Not for a prize but for interest and information.

A further new Award was added to the list, A Tribute to Arihato Award.


